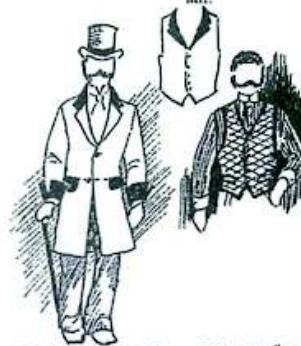

DETACHABLE COLLARS & NECKBAND SHIRTS

Disposable and detachable paper collars were first invented during the Civil War because the northern states couldn't get southern cotton for dress shirts or "boiled" shirts and collars. The shirt with a detachable collar was commonly worn up to the time of World War II, the collar styles changing with the decades. Our factory has been in continuous production since 1864. "Linene" is 100% woven cotton laminated to card stock. "Linex" is linen textured card stock. The collars can withstand several wearings under proper conditions, and can be cleaned with an art gum eraser.
