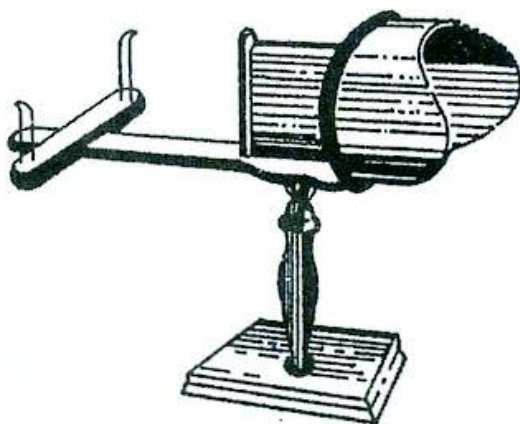

We are often asked for authentic Victorian Christmas gift-wrap, and regretfully, we must tell you there isn't any such thing! Even when the Christmas tree became a universal decoration, gifts were simple small things that were hung on the tree along with sweets, nuts and paper fancies. If a ribbon was used it was just to hang a gift on a branch. Other gifts might be under the tree or hung in paper cornucopias. "Surprise" gifts were generally hidden, or made into simple paper wrapped parcels and marked with a name.

Gift wrapping with special paper is a very modern invention. Plain tissue with gummed stickers and a simple ribbon was used into the 1940's, but with the invention of Scotch tape, fancy gift wraps became popular.

Chromolithographs of small brightly colored scenes, called "scraps," were very popular from the Civil War to World War II. They were originally used to make tree ornaments. Plain tissue, sealed with today's version of "scraps," and tied with a simple Ribbon are as near to an authentic gift wrap as possible. Plain paper and wax seals as listed in the "Pen In Hand" section of this catalog are another gift-wrap possibility.

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
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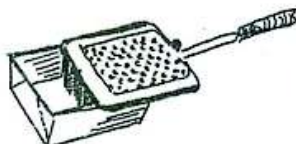
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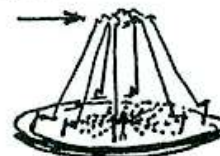


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
